What to bring the very first day: **important!**

#### **For the River :**

- Synthetic long underwear base layer, (Lifa, Louis Garneau),
- Polar fleece or wool sweater,
- Light wind-proof shell (k-way) or paddling jacket,
- Neoprene river booties or amphibious shoes.
- dry-suit or wet-suit (if you own one)
- Neoprene/wool/fleece gloves & hat

**After the River:** Warm clothes, dry change of shoes.

Plan your meals! You are responsible for your own meals. Plan accordingly before arriving & for the duration of the course.

- There will be theory every Saturday night (plan your dinner)
- Camping gear if you wish to camp, we have a full service campground available and free.
